

#### WELCOME

The Stonewater Condominium Association Board of Directors and the homeowners of Stonewater welcome you to our community. We are pleased that you have chosen Stonewater, and we hope you will enjoy your new home. Over the coming months we look forward to meeting you in person, whether it be walking down the streets, at the pool, or at a community activity.

The operation of your condominium association is governed by a board of volunteer directors. The seven Board members are elected on a staggered basis by the community at the annual homeowners meeting in March. The Board is responsible for overseeing the daily functions and finances of the Association and for maintaining compliance with established rules and guidelines. Regular Association meetings are held at 6:00 PM on the fourth Thursday of each month at the Clubhouse, and all homeowners are invited and encouraged to attend these open meetings.

A Condominium Owners Association is quite different from a Homeowner's Association. Condominium community rules and guidelines have been created for the benefit of all owners and are much more comprehensive than those found in other types of communities. Each unit owner will want to have a good understanding of the COA policies.

#### COMMITTEES

All committees are official arms of the board of directors of the association. As such, they follow the same rules regarding notice and minutes. Meetings must be noticed publicly 48 hours in advance of the meeting. Minutes must be taken and become part of the permanent record of the association. All owners are invited and welcome to attend committee meetings.

#### **Architectural Review Committee (ARC)**

The ARC is responsible for interpreting and enforcing the architectural guidelines of the community.

If a homeowner wishes to alter the exterior of a unit, this is called a "material alteration". All proposed material alterations must be submitted to the ARC for review and recommendation to the full board. Materials and colors must be consistent with those previously adopted and already in use. The request to the committee should be fairly detailed and include drawings and materials to be used so the committee has a good understanding of the proposed project. This will ensure a smoother process from concept to approval to completion. Use the Architectural Change Form to initiate your request.

#### **Hospitality Committee**

The purpose of the Hospitality Committee is to facilitate a sense of community among the residents. This is done primarily by welcoming new homeowners to the community and by creating opportunities for social interaction among all residents.

The committee issues a Welcome Booklet for new owners, which provides useful information about the community. A concise written summary can be especially important and helpful for those who have never lived in a condominium environment.

The Hospitality Committee's other main function is to plan events and gatherings for all to attend and enjoy in the company of fellow residents.

#### **Landscape** Committee

The purpose of the landscape committee is to oversee the implementation of landscape projects and to notify the Stonewater manager or board about potential problems or concerns to be addressed.

Owners make landscape requests by completing a landscape work order form. Forms may be found on the wall outside the clubhouse door. The completed form may be turned into the office or dropped in the drop box. Since committee members will contact the homeowner regarding the request, contact information must be provided as requested.

#### **Other Committees**

Other committees are appointed by the board president on an ad hoc basis when they are needed. Examples of such committees are the Budget Committee, which is appointed in the fall, and a Search Committee, which is appointed in the event a new manager is needed. Both the members and the chair are appointed by the board president.

- As a resident of Stonewater, you may enjoy the heated pool and hot tub located directly behind the Clubhouse. Hours are 8 AM to dusk.

- For those who enjoy fishing, the lake within our Stonewater community is available for bank fishing. A freshwater fishing license is not required. Water craft are not permitted on the lake.
